# Kathy Guzlas Scholarship Criteria

## (Up to three \$1000 scholarships)

Scholarship awarded for entrance to a college/university.

- Applicant must be a Glendale Heights resident or an applicant from a family member who is a current active member of the Glendale Heights Chamber of Commerce.
- The applicant must maintain a grade point average of “B” or above (please include a copy of your high school transcripts).
- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- The applicant must show leadership qualities.
- The applicant must show school or community involvement.
- The applicant must submit a typewritten essay or video (no more than 500 words in length for essay or five minutes if doing a video) answering the question: “Using a personal life experience, explain why you are looking to continue your education moving forward?”
- The applicant must include two personal references. At least one of these references must be from a school counselor, administrator or teacher.
- The applicant must include a letter of acceptance from the school they plan to attend.
